There have been several complaints of pets that are running around the neighborhood, attacking and in some cases killing other pets. It is just a matter of time before an attack occurs on one of our children. We ask residents to call Animal Control and report any pet that is roaming the neighborhood. Pets must be kept in a fenced yard or on a leash.

The Homeowner's Association would also like to take this opportunity to remind every resident that as per our subdivision restrictions repeatedly parking vehicles on the street or leaving vehicles parked on the street for an extended period of time is not allowed. This is a rare occurrence, but when it does occur it detracts form the appearance of the entire street.

We are looking into replacing and/or enhancing the landscaping in front of the brick wall along Brightside Drive. Volunteers to draw up plans or help with the work would be most appreciated. In addition, we are still seeking cost estimates to light the oak trees on the median of Riverbend Blvd. If any resident has any special expertise with regard to this type of work and would like to help on this project call Phil Jones at 769-7118.
